Roboto maps 927 characters where DejaVu Sans maps 5918, and sets the same twelve lines from a font file of 159108 bytes against 757076. Compare the two documents, though, and they are within a tenth of each other: a subset carries the glyphs the page uses, so the size on disk hardly reaches the result. Count of characters is not coverage of a document either - what matters is whether the ones actually used are in the file.
