The menu below is set in Niconne wherever Niconne can set it, and in DejaVu Sans where it cannot. Which line got which is decided by trying, because coverage is a property of the file and not of the language.

Čevapčići	DejaVu Sans	no glyph for U+010C
Bigos z żurawiną	DejaVu Sans	no glyph for U+017C
Şiş kebab	DejaVu Sans	no glyph for U+015E

Niconne carries 283 characters against DejaVu Sans with 5918. Both Polish dishes above are Polish; one sets and one does not. Coverage is a property of the file, and the only way to know it is to ask the file.

The same lines, decided per character

Above, one missing letter costs the whole line its face. With -fallback the display face keeps everything it has, and only the letters it lacks come from DejaVu Sans.
